

## Canadian Firearms Safety Course for Non-restricted Firearms Randy Billyboy, CFSC Non-restricted Firearms Instructor

To do a **COURSE**, my rate is **\$50.00/person** for two days of teaching **12 people max**.  
**New changes made by the CFSC/RCMP to limitation in a course.**

Make sure each individual pays their \$50 which commits them to attend. This is if the band isn't covering their cost to attend. Have 2 or 3 people on standby in case some people can't make the course.

After an individual passes this course, he or she will have to pay **\$60.00** to get their **LICENCE** similar to the five year deal you get with getting your driver's licence. Make it payable to: **RECEIVER GENERAL**, which should be sent along with their course report, picture identification, background information in their envelopes. On my end, it take me 5 to 6 hours to process each person's information then mail off my information the next day.

For **YOUTH** 17 years to 12 years, their parents or guardian must have a P.A.L. and call 1-800-731-4000 to the Chief Firearms Officer to get a Minors Licence application mailed to them. After they have the forms in hand, then they can join the regular course. Depending on the youth's age they either pay \$30.00, \$20.00 or \$10.00 for their licence. When they turn 18 years of age, they can go through another course for their Possession and Acquisitions Licence.

To prevent applicant's mail from getting lost, I recommend it get sent by **REGISTERED MAIL**. It may cost more, but it won't be the individual's fault for lost mail.

It takes 30 minutes/person to go through the PRACTICAL exam. This includes for me to check their forms get them ready for mailing. It should take between 5 hours to 6 hours.

Averaging 12 to 15 hours within the 2 days.

**Saturday Schedule:**

10:00 am - Start the written exam – 30 minutes to an hour.
